About the University

The Maharshi Valmiki Sanskrit University, Mundri (Moundhara), Kapisthalm (MVSU) is a state university established in 2018 by the Government of Haryana at Mundri village district Kaithal, Haryana. It is situated 12 km East of Kaithal, 111 km from the state capital Chandigarh, and 164 km from the national capital, New Delhi. The university currently is operating from its temporary campus at Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Govt. College, Kaithal while its campus is being constructed at Mundri village (Kaithal). It is named after the Hindu sage "Maharshi Valmiki" who was the composer of the "Ramayana". He is also known as the "Adi-Kavi" of the "Sanskrit" language. It is believed that Maharshi Valmiki Ashram was situated in Mundri village. The chief vision of the university is to revive "Sanskrit" and its wealthy wisdom through "Sanskrit" teaching and research, in addition, to bring back the glory of Vedas, Indic languages, Indian culture, history, and Indian philosophy on the platform of the modern world.

About the Conference

History is not only a discipline but also the mother of all knowledge traditions. In the absence of constant and unbiased deliberation, it becomes lifeless like still water. The history of 'Bharatvarsha' demands for a re-narration, reinterpretation, and rediscovery. 
